Sungwon Yoon, Managing Director of POSCO Australia Pty Ltd

Mr Yoon is the Managing Director of POSCO Australia Pty Ltd, located in Sydney. After joining POSCO in 1992, Mr Yoon has focused on the steel making raw materials during his career. He has over 20 years' experience in various roles and responsibilities across POSCO's raw materials procurement, investment, strategy and transportation. Before assuming the Managing Director role of POSCO Australia in February 2016, Mr Yoon was the General Manager of the POSCO coal procurement group.



Dongjin Kim, Managing Director, GS E&C Australia

Dongjin Kim is currently the Managing Director of GS E&C in Australia. GS E&C is construction arm of GS Group, in which is 7th largest conglomerate in Korea, with U\$ 60 Bil. revenue through Oil&Gas, Retail, International Trading and Construction.

GS E&C, are a reputable international general contractor with specialty in Civil Infrastructure, Architecture & Housing, Environment, Power & Refinery Plants. They have U\$ 51.1 bil. accumulated value of overseas contracts and in 2016, new orders amounted to U\$ 11.4 bil. and revenue U\$10 bil. GS E&C were rated 22nd in International Contract sector by the Engineering News Record (ENR) in 2016. GS E&C have successfully carried out rails, roads, tunnels, bridges, airports and marine works with expertise recognized by domestic and overseas clients since 1969. GS E&C Australia Pty Ltd was established in March 2017 and they are currently exploring business opportunities in the civil infrastructure sector, not only as a contractor but also as equity investors in PPP projects.



Daewon Yu, Project Development Manager, Hanwha Energy

Daewon Yu is the country manager of Australia for Hanwha Energy, a company that specialises in the development, acquisition and operation of large scale solar power plants. Daewon has helped Hanwha complete its first equity investment in Australia through the acquisition of Barcardine solar farm in Queensland. Prior to this, Daewon has led Hanwha Q Cells' joint bid for the 350MW tender in Abu Dhabi (UAE) and also successfully finalized the co-development of solar farms totaling 200MW in India with local developers.

Hanwha Energy is an IPP company with operating assets in Korea, US, Japan, India and Australia. In comparison to its affiliate company Hanwha Q Cells - which manufactures solar panels and does the EPC work to construct solar farms - Hanwha Energy focuses on developing potential solar sites from earlier stages of land acquisitions through to financial close. While Hanwha Q Cells has been in Australia for more than 7 years, Hanwha Energy is now looking to set up its own office to drive development activities further on the ground.
